

Throw right things into the inlet



RESIDUAL WASTE

Do this: Use plastic bags to the residual waste. Tie the bag well.

For example: diapers, envelopes, smaller gadgets of plastic and paper (not packages), cat litter, dishwashing brushes, dishcloths and vacuum cleaner bags.



FOOD WASTE

Do this: Use only the special paper bag for the food waste.

For example: Remains of meat, fish, seafood, pasta, rice, fruit, bread, vegetables, eggshells, coffee grounds, coffee filters and cut flowers.



NEWSPAPER/PAPER

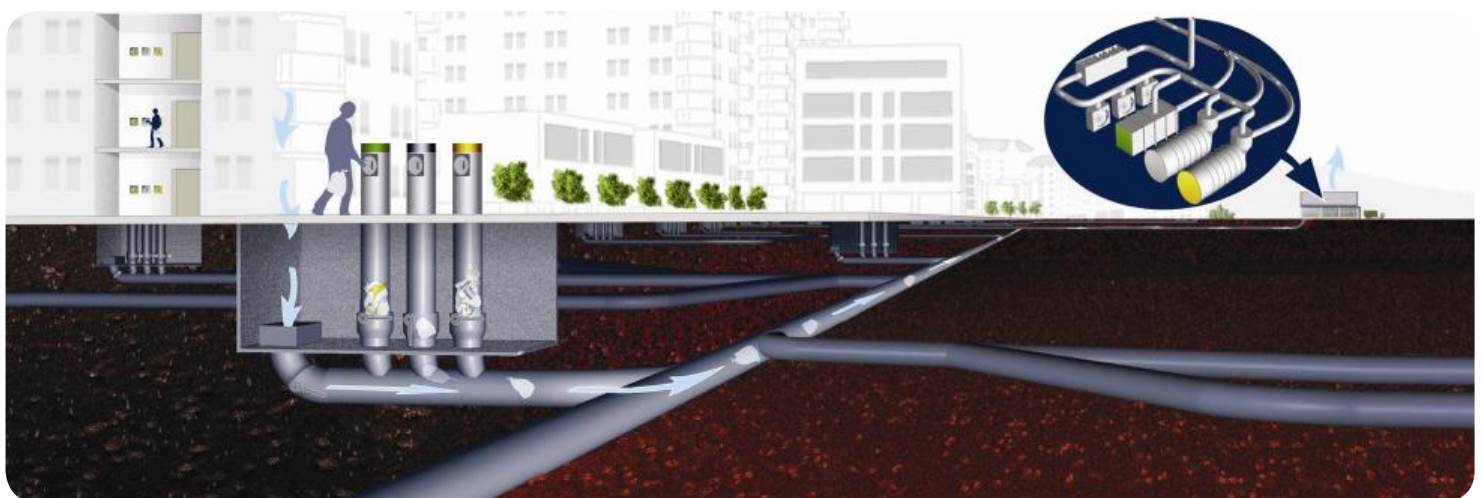
Do this: Throw the papers in small bunches, no bags.

For example: daily newspapers, magazines, brochures, leaflets, catalogues and copying paper

N.B. Do not throw the following in here; post-it notes, envelopes, plastic or paper bags or laminated paper. These are to be thrown in with the residual waste.

Do not throw everything into the inlets

Pizza boxes, bag in box packages (if they are not torn into smaller pieces first), firs, styrofoam and corrugated cardboard, binders and frying pans should not be placed here. It can cause a blockage!



A vacuum waste system is collecting the residual waste in your area. The only thing you can see of the system is the garbage inlets. The picture above shows how a vacuum waste system works.

Recyclable material are collected at the nearest local recycling station.
